

## Anchorage Public Library Online Resources Library Scavenger Hunt (Grades 6+)

**Instructions:** This scavenger hunt can be completed online or in library using our computers Students may work together in groups and with their teachers. Librarians are available to give instruction on databases and online resources at a library location or for a group in an outside location (like a school, homeschool, scout group, church group, etc).

While this online scavenger hunt is primarily designed for middle school and high school students, questions that are appropriate for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders are marked with an \*.
